

HOW TO TRADE & STAKE GNOD ON OSMOSIS DEX

Buy OSMO > Keplr Wallet > Osmosis DEX > OSMO → GNOD > Stake in Vaultix | Beginner Guide

Keplr Wallet	Chrome Web Store (search Keplr)	Free browser extension for Chrome or Brave	<i>Your personal wallet — stores your OSMO, USDC, and GNOD</i>
Osmosis DEX	app.osmosis.zone	Decentralized crypto exchange built on Cosmos	<i>Where you buy OSMO, swap tokens, and trade for GNOD</i>
Swapped.com	Osmosis → Buy Crypto → Swapped	Credit card / Apple Pay on-ramp built into Osmosis	<i>How you buy OSMO with a credit card — no separate account needed</i>
OSMO	Buy via Swapped on Osmosis	The Osmosis network's own token	<i>Your one credit card purchase — used for fees and swapped into GNOD</i>
USDC (Noble)	Swap from OSMO on Osmosis	Digital dollar always worth ~\$1.00, native to Cosmos via Noble	<i>Optional middle step when trading OSMO → GNOD manually (Steps 4B + 5)</i>
GNOD	Swap on Osmosis	Gnodi's native blockchain token	<i>What you're here to buy — and stake in Vaultix to earn rewards</i>
Vaultix Wallet	App.VaultixWallet.com	Your Gnodi wallet and staking home base	<i>Where you send GNOD to stake and earn rewards</i>

■ How Much OSMO to Buy

Buy the dollar amount you want to invest in GNOD, plus an extra \$3–5 for fees. Example: want \$100 in GNOD? Buy \$105 of OSMO. Osmosis will route your trade automatically — just keep ~\$5 in OSMO for transaction fees. You will always need a small OSMO balance for fees on future trades.

#	STEP	HOW TO DO IT	WHY
1	Download & Set Up Keplr	1. In Chrome or Brave, open the Chrome Web Store. 2. Search Keplr and click Add to Chrome → Add Extension. 3. Click the puzzle icon (top right) and pin Keplr for easy access. 4. Open Keplr and choose one option: ◆ Create New Wallet — if you're brand new to crypto. ◆ Import Existing Wallet — enter your Vaultix seed phrase to bring your Vaultix wallet into Keplr. 5. Write your 12- or 24-word recovery phrase on paper. Never in a photo, text, or email. 6. Copy your wallet address — it starts with osmo1... You will need this address in Step 2.	<i>Keplr is your personal wallet and the bridge to Osmosis DEX. Since Vaultix is Cosmos-based, importing it into Keplr is seamless — same wallet, accessible in both places.</i>
2	Buy OSMO with Credit Card via Swapped	1. Go to app.osmosis.zone in your browser. 2. Click Buy Crypto (top of page or in the menu). 3. Select Swapped from the options. 4. Enter the dollar amount you want to spend (see How Much box above). 5. Make sure OSMO is selected as the token you receive. 6. Choose your payment method (Apple Pay, credit card, etc.) — fee is 1.75%. 7. When prompted for a wallet address, paste your Keplr address (osmo1...). 8. Complete the purchase. OSMO arrives in your Keplr wallet within minutes.	<i>Swapped is built directly into Osmosis — no separate account needed. Your OSMO lands straight in your Keplr wallet, ready to trade.</i>
3	Connect Keplr to Osmosis DEX	1. Go to app.osmosis.zone in your browser. 2. Click Connect Wallet (top right corner). 3. Select Keplr from the wallet list. 4. A Keplr pop-up asks for permission — click Approve. 5. Your osmo1... address now appears on Osmosis. You're connected.	<i>Connecting Keplr only gives Osmosis read access. It cannot move your funds without you approving each individual transaction in Keplr.</i>

Step 4 — Pick A or B

Step 4A is the simplest path — one swap, Osmosis handles everything in the background. Use Steps 4B + 5 if you want to hold USDC first, trade in smaller amounts, or see each step separately.

4 A	Swap OSMO → GNOD Direct (Recommended)	1. On Osmosis, click Swap in the top menu. 2. Top field (From): select OSMO. 3. Bottom field (To): search and select GNOD. 4. Enter the amount of OSMO to swap (leave \$3–5 worth of OSMO for fees). 5. Review the estimated GNOD you will receive and the OSMO fee. 6. Click Swap → Approve in the Keplr pop-up. 7. Done — your GNOD balance updates within seconds.	<i>The simplest path for beginners. Osmosis automatically routes your OSMO through USDC in the background to get the best price — you don't need to do anything extra.</i>
4 B	Swap OSMO → USDC (Noble) Manual Step 1	1. On Osmosis, click Swap in the top menu. 2. Top field (From): select OSMO. 3. Bottom field (To): search and select USDC — confirm it shows USDC (Noble). 4. Enter the amount of OSMO to swap (leave \$3–5 worth of OSMO for fees). 5. Review the estimated USDC you will receive. 6. Click Swap → Approve in the Keplr pop-up. 7. Your USDC (Noble) balance updates within seconds.	<i>Use this if you want to hold USDC first before buying GNOD, or trade into GNOD in smaller amounts over time. USDC is always worth ~\$1.00 so there is no price risk while you decide.</i>
5	Swap USDC → GNOD (Manual Step 2)	1. Stay on the Swap page on Osmosis. 2. Top field (From): select USDC (Noble). 3. Bottom field (To): search and select GNOD. 4. Enter the amount of USDC you want to spend. 5. Review the estimated GNOD and the OSMO fee. 6. Click Swap → Approve in the Keplr pop-up. 7. Done — your GNOD balance updates within seconds.	<i>Second half of the manual route. Only needed if you completed Step 4B. If you used Step 4A, skip this — you already have GNOD.</i>
6	Swap GNOD → USDC (Sell GNOD)	1. On Osmosis, click Swap in the top menu. 2. Top field (From): select GNOD. 3. Bottom field (To): select USDC (Noble). 4. Enter the amount of GNOD you want to sell. 5. Review the estimated USDC and OSMO fee. 6. Click Swap → Approve in Keplr. 7. You can hold the USDC on Osmosis, swap back to OSMO, or send to Vaultix.	<i>Selling is the reverse of buying. Your USDC will appear in Osmosis after the swap — withdraw to Vaultix or keep trading any time.</i>

7	Send GNOD to Vaultix & Stake to Earn Rewards	1. In Osmosis, click Assets in the left menu. 2. Find your GNOD balance and click Withdraw. 3. Enter your Vaultix wallet address as the destination. 4. Confirm the amount and submit. Transfer takes 30 seconds–2 minutes. 5. Log in to App.VaultixWallet.com and confirm your GNOD arrived. 6. Navigate to the Stake section in Vaultix. 7. Select GNOD, enter the amount you want to stake, and confirm. 8. Your staked GNOD begins earning rewards automatically.	<i>Staking puts your GNOD to work. Instead of sitting idle, staked GNOD earns you additional GNOD rewards over time — the more you stake and the longer you hold, the more you earn.</i>
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■ Recovery Phrase	Never screenshot or email your recovery phrase. Write it on paper and store it safely. Anyone with this phrase has full access to your wallet.
■ Address Safety	Always paste wallet addresses — never type manually. Double-check the first and last 4 characters before sending any funds.
■ Keep OSMO for Fees	Always keep \$3–5 worth of OSMO in your Keplr wallet. Every transaction on Osmosis requires a small OSMO fee. If you run out, trades will fail.
■ USDC (Noble)	On Osmosis you may see multiple USDC options. Always select USDC (Noble) — it is the official Cosmos version and the correct one for trading GNOD.
■ Staking	You can stake any amount of GNOD — there is no minimum. Rewards are paid in GNOD and compound over time. You can unstake at any time.
